Infectious Disease Control and Management Policy

Inclusive Sport SA Incorporated (ISSA) recognises that Infectious Disease is a public concern and will actively seek to promote and encourage all precautions to be followed at all events co-ordinated by ISSA.

Although the risk of being infected with an infectious disease or a blood borne virus through participation in sport is very low, ISSA seeks to minimise this risk even further. Any person working with participants must assume that everyone maybe infectious whether from a cold, flu or a more serious blood-borne infectious disease. ISSA recommends that all workers in a situation involving contact with blood and or bodily fluid, view it as a potential risk situation and take preventative measures.
