Policy

Inclusive Sport SA (ISSA) Incorporated recognises that passive smoking is hazardous to health, and non-smokers should be protected from tobacco smoke. Accordingly, the policy requirements apply to all members, administrators, officials, coaches, participants and visitors to the ISSA office or any other venue being used by ISSA.

Responsibilities

It is the responsibility of all workers to comply with this policy.

Requirements

The Smoke Free Policy requires:

- Administration and office areas be smoke-free
- All Inclusive Sport SA functions, including events, competitions, dinners, fundraising events, and meetings of the organisation are smoke free.
- Coaches, coordinators, trainers, volunteers and officials are to refrain from smoking whilst acting in an official capacity.
- Players refrain from smoking whilst in uniform
- The effects of smoking on performance will be discussed with participants
- Smoke-free behaviour will be incorporated into the code of behaviour for coaches and players
- Participants will comply with all no-smoking messages or signs at venues at which they are representing Sasrapid, or are part of an ISSA organised event or competition.

Non-compliance with this policy will result in action deemed appropriate by the Chief Executive Officer.
